Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. 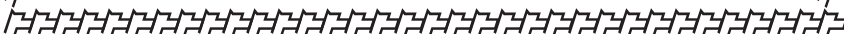

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

AKC Sanctioned 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition

Entry Fee: \$22.00 per puppy

This is a recorded event by the AKC for the Certificate of Merit and Puppy of Achievement certificates.

Section 1 - Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the first day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Notice to Exhibitors

DAY PARKING is available on the grounds for \$10.00 per day or \$15.00 for a 2-day Pass.

FREE GROOMING BUILDING is provided, with power, on a first-come first-serve basis. No x-pens or gas generators are allowed in any building. No Grooming or setups allowed in Main Building or Obedience/Rally Building.

MAIN BUILDING CRATING is allowed, at least 10 feet from rings, during judging and immediately before judging. Remove crates as soon as judging of your breed is complete. Crates may not remain in Main Building once group judging begins, or overnight.

RALLY/OBEDIENCE BUILDING CRATING is allowed, at least 10 feet from rings, during show hours, and may remain overnight Saturday. Crates must be removed by end of judging Sunday.

OCCUPANCY: Dogs must be removed from all buildings by 6:00 P.M. each day.

SETUPS: Front lawn outside Main Building is available for personal setups and pop-up tenting.

CLEANING UP: After your own dogs is your responsibility, which includes hair and trimmings in grooming buildings, as well as waste pickup. These are self-cleaning shows.

Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs

That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, *regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards*. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made.
